In 1999, Oceaneering was awarded a contract by Woodside Energy and its partners Apache Energy and Santos Limited, to provide a jackup mobile offshore production unit (MOPU) for installation on the Legendre development, approximately 100 kilometers offshore Dampier, Australia. Oceaneering converted the Marine 7 unit, a Bethlehem JV-375-TMS mat supported mobile offshore drilling unit (MODU), into the *Ocean Legend* MOPU.

For the conversion, Oceaneering performed all conceptual engineering, developed budgets and schedules, and specified and procured all topside equipment. Oceaneering also provided all project management including interface, quality assurance and HSE management programs.

In January 2001, the *Ocean Legend* was installed on location in water depths of 60m. Following drilling and completion of the wells, first oil was produced on May 17, 2001. The *Ocean Legend* can process up to 55,000 bopd that is transferred to a third party floating storage and offloading (FSO) tanker.

The *Ocean Legend* is wholly owned and operated by Oceaneering International, Inc.
